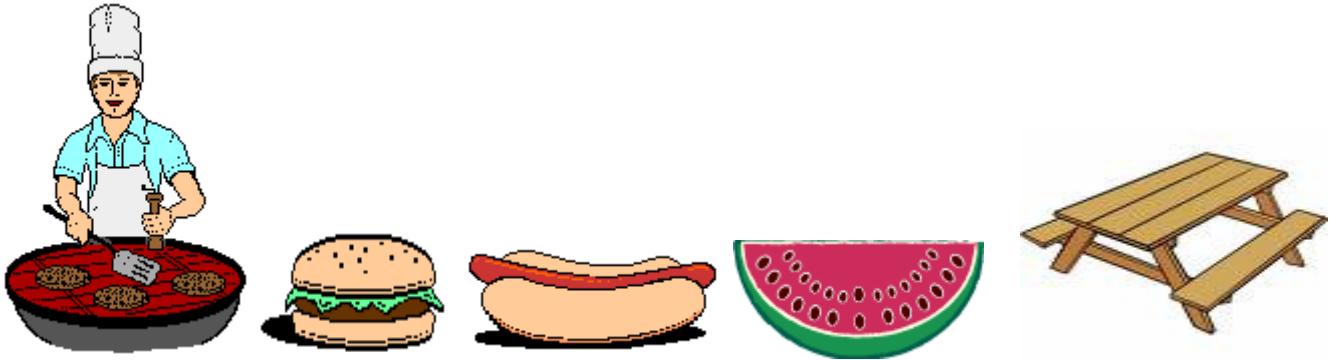
Merchandise
